We hope you are well, had a relaxing holiday break and a great start to Term 2.

Term 1 went by quickly. The Cluster 10 IY Team did a great job at delivering the IY programmes online using the Zoom platform. The feedback from teachers was positive with lots of new learning taking place. With New Zealand now at Orange Light settings, we are now running all IY Programmes face to face. We are encouraging mask use and asking teachers to wear masks in workshop sessions in Term 2.



# News and Updates:

New IY Facilitators - We welcome Ben Afele and Tauai Salelea-Manson to the IY Team. They completed their training in Term 1 and will be delivering future IYT workshops. We also welcome Marjorie Rinckes who has joined our Cluster and is a trained IY facilitator.

Incredible Years Teacher Programme 2 facilitated by Karen Otway and Laura Campbell has got off to a great start with three more workshops this term. The feedback from teachers enrolled so far has been positive.

Incredible Years Autism Programme for Teachers and Teacher Aides (IYAT) - Amanda Bell and Susan Knowles completed online zoom sessions for their 2021 programme in Term 1. The Term 2 programme commenced on 13 May. We will be offering another IYAT programme in Term 3. More information about this will be emailed later this term.

Managing Behaviour Positively - Teacher Aide workshops - we will offer Teacher Aide workshops in Term 3. More information about these workshops will be emailed later this term.



If a teacher is enrolled in the Incredible Years Programme, we would like the teacher to be offered the option to be referred to the RTLB service for one term, once the IY course finishes. The IY facilitators will be allocated these referrals and will be able to support the teacher/s with implementing and

embedding IY strategies in their classroom and provide coaching support. This will give teachers more confidence to continue using what they have learned in the IY workshops, making IY more sustainable in their classroom.
