Cluster Manager Comment:

This term we had Kathryn Berkett speak with staff from schools. The feedback from this session has been very positive. Some schools are working together to get Kathryn to talk with their whole staff so that everyone has the same knowledge and understanding to help them support students that they work with. RTLB may be able to support with some funding to pay for Kathryn's costs, please talk with Tamara about what options could be available.

Transition Requests for Support:

At the beginning of the year, your Liaison RTLB would have shared a calendar with you of important dates. This is a reminder that one of the dates pertains to transition requests. As we draw to the end of Term 2, I would like to remind schools well ahead of time that we need Transition Requests for Support to be submitted by the end of Week 8 in Term 3. This allows enough time for RTLB to carry out their mahi. This applies specifically for students who are transitioning between education settings e.g. Primary school to Intermediate. If you would like support to develop your in-school transition processes e.g. Year 1 to Year 2, please talk with your Liaison and we can support with an individualised workshop to meet your needs.

General Requests for Support

If you are requiring RTLB support please get these in as soon as possible in Term 3 so that RTLB have enough time to provide quality support. In Term 4, the main focus of RTLB work is transition and completing Requests for Support that have been received during 2023. In Term 4 we will be accepting:

- Starting School Requests
- Transition requests that have been negotiated with the Cluster Manager who did not meet the
 Term 3 cut off
- Requests for students who will be staying with the same teacher in 2024
- Any other requests submitted in Term 4 will be allocated at our first allocation meeting in Term 1 which is 31 January 2024
